Tobias A. Nassif, *Vice President Space Operations*: As PanAmSat's vice president of space operations, Tobias is responsible for the overall management of the company's satellite fleet and the ground system used to control them as well as the operation and maintenance of third party spacecraft. This includes the 24/7 operation of the spacecraft, orbit analysis and maneuver planning of the fleet, coordination of spacecraft movement with other satellite operators, restoration from and resolution of spacecraft anomalies as well as the acquisition and maintenance of the ground systems required for their continued operation.

Prior to coming to PanAmSat, Mr. Nassif has had an extensive career in operations. Most recently he was Director of Operations for the Naval Satellite Operations Center (NAVSOC), responsible for leading the overall operation of the Navy's global communication satellite fleet and associated terrestrial facilities. Prior to his entry onto the space field, Mr. Nassif's eleven years of active duty in the US Navy included tours on various naval warships in a variety of operations roles. Mr. Nassif's association with PanAmSat dates back to 1996, where as Deputy Director of Operations for NAVSOC he was responsible for the coordination of HCI/PanAmSat's LEASAT program activities. Hired as PanAmSat's vice president of space operations in February of 2002, he holds a Masters of Science in Information Technology Management from the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, a BA in History from Case Western Reserve University, Cleveland, OH, and is a graduate of the Federal Executive Institute.
