### Task

Review the Prototype Team Assignment (follow link from 577a Schedule) and the teams Prototyping Results Document. Produce a report in which you evaluate the team prototype effort and results. In addition to the general issues described in the *IV&V Assignments & General Guidelines*, you should consider the following.

1. Taxonomy Elements Negotiation Topics
  - a. Are negotiation topics ambiguous?
2. Win Conditions
  - a. Are the win conditions ambiguous?
  - b. Are the win conditions correctly categorized?
  - c. Is there an agreement for each?
  - d. Is there at least one option for each issue that has been agreed on?
  - e. Are there any open options or issues associated with any win condition?
3. Keywords:
  - a. Are they concisely defined?
  - b. Is the list complete? If not what other keywords that need to be defined based on the wording of the win conditions.
4. Issues.
  - a. Does each issue have at least one option?
  - b. Does each issue have the stakeholder identified?
  - c. Are they well enough defined that all stakeholders will understand.
5. Options.
  - a. Is the issue and proposing stakeholder identified?

- b. Are they well enough defined that all stakeholders will understand.
- 6. Agreements.
  - a. Are they concisely defined?
  - b. Is everyone agreed on all of them?
- 7. Check the Win–Win artifacts.
  - a. Are they are all categorized correctly using the taxonomy elements?

Of course you should explain your answers.
