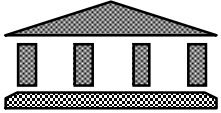

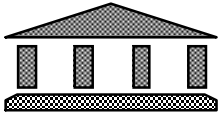

**Use only on-campus computers?**

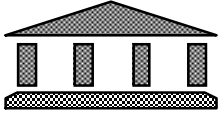


# Location

**On Campus: Until UCS makes Rose98i, RUP and SODA available throughout campus, go to Bridge-2 (Keck Lab) or Hoffman-3? Available from 9/25 onward; maybe slow.**

**Off-site students and those wishing to work at home**

- Download and install the 20 day evaluation version of Rose 98i: [www.rational.com/products/rose/tryit/eval.jtimpl](http://www.rational.com/products/rose/tryit/eval.jtimpl) [link also on Inside UML CD, Box 3, "Hands-on with Rose" tab]
- Use the 20 day evaluation start-up license until you receive a 577a start-up license (good until Dec 7!).
  - Off-site students will be sent a single sheet of paper with the required start-up license.
  - On Campus students who work "off campus" should pick up their start-up license from the TA after class
